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'SHASAN APLYA DARI' YOJANA

INTRODUCTION:

'Shasan aplya dari' yojana meaning government at your doorstep. Shri Eknath Shinde, the Chief Minister of Maharashtra, has introduced this new programme on May 2023. The Shinde-Fadnavis-Ajit Pawar Government is holding programmes in different cities to launch 'Shasan Aplya Dari' (government at your doorstep scheme) with the Chief Minister and his two deputies attending all the programmes. To reach maximum voters, Maharashtra government aimed at providing benefits of government schemes under one roof.

This scheme was launched at the district of Satara by organising a two-day camp for the people to create awareness regarding the government schemes that were launched for the benefit of the various schemes. Later the programmes have also been held at Latur, Kolhapur, Gadchiroli, and Nashik. As a result of this drive, people should be able to take advantage of all government programs and avail the facility of getting the documents supplied under one roof. Before launching of this scheme, the common people have to move from one department to other to understand the process of a particular government scheme and sometimes they have even to stand and wait in a long queue.

For coordination, a special cell has been established in the CM's office. The funding granted to various departments can be used by district collectors to plan the camps. Government have also provided free buses for common people to reach the camps and grab the opportunities. 82 officers and employees were

appointed to help and solve the problem of common people regarding the scheme.

OBJECT OF THE SCHEME:

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The Object of the scheme is that in this scheme people get benefit of all government schemes under one roof without any hassle. Under this scheme camps have been arranged for agricultural, rural development, social Justice, tribal development, skill development etc. This scheme was introduced to discuss the various problems that the people are facing. Government had organized this camp to solve all the problems of the people. The government tried to reach 25 lakh people and till date 8,74738 people have already received benefit from this scheme.

This scheme has a dedicated cell that has been set up in the Chief Minister Office. The district collector has been authorised to use funds allocated to various departments such as agricultural, rural development, social Justice, tribal development, skill development, school education, etc. From this scheme members of legislative assembly can utilise funds for the District Planning and development committee purpose. Government declares order to government officers to provide information of all the government schemes and government camps to common people.

To ensure the success rate of the project, the district administrations have been requested to plan two-day camps within their spheres of influence. As part of the campaign, they have been instructed to provide benefits to about 75,000 residents. For the purpose of setting up the camps, the district collectors have

been given permission to spend money granted to a number of different departments.

The basic idea of this scheme is to reach the last person standing in the queue. This scheme goal is to bring the government at the doorsteps of common people of our country, so that they can easily get benefit of the numerous government programmes under one roof without any hassle.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

The documents that we require to avail this scheme are:

- Aadhar card
- Pan card
- Permanent residence certificate
- Passport size photo
- Mobile number

There are number of issues which the common and the poor man face like literacy, education, knowledge and the facilities available at their end. Whereas, the basic idea was to solve the issues of the people at grassroots level. This is to reduce red tapism in the Bureaucracy and void corruption at administrative levels. The government aims to spread the message to people desirous of these facilities especially residing in remote areas. That's why the system is developed to educate the people about various scheme policies that have been

implemented and to give direct advantage to the people in rural areas like livestock insurance, Crop Insurance, etc.

Government's mission is to bring diverse benefits directly to our doorsteps, ensuring hassle-free access and empowering ourselves to make the utmost use of the available opportunities, to unlock the potential of government schemes effortlessly with 'Shasan aplya dari' yojana'.

PORTAL

ShasanAplyaDari.com is an informative platform where in people can get all the information in the arena of various schemes. This website provides valuable information and resources for the public benefit. This website is an independent entity and not an official government website. The Maharashtra Gyan Maha-Mandal created the Maha-Labharthi portal. To get the benefit of this scheme the applicant must be a permanent resident of Maharashtra and also the applicant must be applying for different types of welfare schemes presented in the Maharashtra state.

In the past one year, Shri Eknath Shinde led government, announced various initiatives targeting different communities and sizeable professional groups. On Saturday May 2023, Hon'ble Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and his two deputies Shri Devendra Fadnavis and Shri Ajit Pawar attended the event in Nashik. Despite being a government programme, the ruling parties ensured to put up their party flags at the public event. "The government are now focussing on execution of schemes of direct benefit to woo small vote banks with assembly

elections due next year." This was the observation that was made by a political observer.

VARIOUS PROGRAMMES

The government organized various Programmes for the people. The programmes were:

- Employment Fair
- Health Camp
- Blood donation camp
- Distribution of materials to the disabled
- Agricultural Exhibition
- Farmer to consumer direct market

Ahead of the programme, various government departments identified applicants seeking various benefits and they were given certificates. According to officials, around two lakh beneficiaries were identified in Nashik district. Earlier the programme was planned in Pune district at Jejuri but was cancelled.

According to Eknath Shinde, Maharashtra government completed one year, and are putting their achievements in front of the citizens. He also said, "The government is trying to reach 27 lakh citizens by giving them direct benefit of the schemes". Devendra Fadnavis said, "The intention of the programme is to give benefits of government schemes to the citizens directly at their doorstep. In the last public event, Ajit Pawar stated that his party flags were missing, however, in the Nashik event government had flags of all the three parties."

ADVANTAGES OF SCHEME:

- 1. A lot of benefits will be provided to the people who will be targeted through the development of this scheme.
- 2. People will be eligible to apply for the different types of welfare schemes without having to visit the government office.
- 75000 people will be benefited through the development of this
 prestigious scheme and doorstep delivery of all of the services will be
 provided to them.
- 4. The main objective of this scheme is that people can take full advantage of government schemes.
- 5. The main objective of this yojana is to make various schemes accessible by the government to the people so that they can also take advantage of these welfare schemes.
- 6. In this scheme, the government will go directly to the local level and will give the benefits of the schemes to the common citizen.
- 7. For the benefits of government schemes, people do not need to wander here and there, they will get the benefits of various schemes under one roof.
- 8. The campaigning of this scheme, will be done door-to-door, to inform about the plan and scheme by the administration and thereafter, a camp will be organized in which people can take benefits of the scheme directly.

DISADVANTAGES OF SCHEME:

1. People are not literate at all. Many a times, people even don't know the schemes that are implemented for the common people.

- 2. Government doesn't have right approach towards issues faced by the people. Hence, fails to address the issues.
- 3. The communicators from government side are not giving their 100 % in creating awareness among the people about various schemes.

1. Benefits of MNREGA scheme facility:

The Government of India introduced the MGNREGA social welfare programme in 2005 to address the problem of unemployment and poverty in rural areas.

The primary objective of the scheme is to guarantee 100 days of employment in every financial year to adult members of any rural household willing to do public work- or unskilled manual work.

Problems that people faced in the scheme:

- Ridiculously low wage rate
- Regular payment delays
- Non-payment of unemployment allowance

Measures taken by government to solve the issue:

To understand their problems and solve the issue regarding the scheme government started the 'Shasan aplya dari' yojana and started solving issues at the doorsteps. They explained the advantages of MNREGA scheme clearly to them.

2. Benefits of Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojna:

Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana is implemented as a central sector scheme by the Government of India. This scheme was introduced to augment the source of income of many small and marginal farmers.

Problems faced by people in the scheme:

Farmers whose names are not included in the beneficiaries' list of PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana should approach the district-level grievance redressal monitoring committee in their districts for inclusion of their names in the beneficiaries' list of PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana.

Measures taken by government to solve the issue:

New Farmer Registration: Government officers helped the farmers who were not registered in the scheme. Using this scheme, farmers can submit mandatory details like self-declaration about the eligibility to get the benefit of PM-Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana online.

The form is then sent by an automated process to the State Nodal Officer (SNO) for verification. The State Nodal Officer (SNO) verifies the details filled by the farmers and uploads the verified data on the PM-KISAN portal. Thereafter, the data is processed through an established system resulting in the payment process.

3.Pf Gharkul Yojana Facility:

The Maharashtra state government launched the Ramai Awas Yojana to give housing to persons from Scheduled Tribes, Scheduled Castes, and Neo-Buddhist castes, which stated that there will be a total of 51 lakh dwellings distributed in the coming year, whereas, 1.5 lakh have already been finished. There will be a total of 22,676 new dwellings erected in the urban region, with 11,3571 new houses created in the rural sector. The Department of Social Justice has been given authority to carry out the same activities for the entire fiscal year 2021-2022.

4. Marriage Registration facility:

People did not understand or know the correct process to get their marriages registered in the court. Therefore, the 'Shasan aplya dari' scheme has been started to resolve this issue.

5. E-Shram Card facility:

Any person working in an unorganised sector can apply for an E-Shram card or Shramik card. The labourers working in unorganised sectors can obtain various benefits through the e-Shram card, such as a pension amount after 60 years, death insurance, financial aid in case of incapacity, UAN number, etc.

Problems faced by the people:

Ramendra Kumar, founding member of Delhi Shramik Sangathan announced that only 60 workers are allowed to register in a day. Therefore, workers had to stand in a long queue to get themselves registered.

Measures taken by government to solve the issue:

Therefore, to solve the issue doorstep service was provided to the workers so that they do not need to stand in a long queue every day after their tiring work.

6. License of agricultural service centre:

For the growth of Agro-Industries and to manage the schedule of products for export by defining norms and specification for export Indian government has established many organisations. Exports should register with an authorised export promotion Agencies and obtain a registration membership certificate to receive benefits and concessions under Export Import policy.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

As the farmers were not much educated therefore, they could not understand how to register themselves for the agriculture license number.

Hence, under the 'Shasan aplya dari' scheme government officers explained and helped them with the problem and came to their rescue.

7. Job card facility:

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005 (MGNREGA) provides job cards to poor families across the countries which contain the details of the work to be done by the job card holder or NREGA beneficiary. Every year, new NREGA job card is prepared for each beneficiary which can be easily checked on the official website of MGNREGA at nrega.nic.in.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

As its information was mostly available on the internet, many of the people faced difficulties to register themselves online.

Therefore, government officers helped people at their residence by registering them online for the job card facility.

8. Registration of basic documents:

The basic documents that are required even of a small child such as Aadhar card, pan card registration, passport and even of a 18 years adult such as Learner's license, voter card, etc are the basic required documents of a person. Therefore, government made available the facilities for the people at their residence so that they do not have to face problems for registering themselves for getting the aforesaid documents. Also, the people do not have to stand in the queues going to the centres and would be able to receive the documents at their doorsteps.

Apart from these schemes, people can get the benefit of more schemes at their doorsteps. The schemes are:

- 1. Asmita Yojana registration
- 2. Namo Shetkari Sanman Yojana
- 3. Tarbandi yojana
- 4. Mission Vatsalya Scheme

1. Asmita Yojana Registration:

This scheme was started by the government for the benefit of women and girls of our state. This scheme can also be called as health scheme. Under this scheme, the women and the school girls are provided with low-cost sanitary pads. This scheme was started by the government so that women and girls do not compromise with their health. The price of the sanitary pads for school going girls are 5Rs and for the women prices increase to 24Rs or 29 Rs.

Process for registration:

- 1. First, people need to go to the official website regasmita.mahaonline.gov.in.
- 2. Now on the homepage, register button needs to be clicked.
- 3. Now registration form opens.
- 4. Now Applicant's Aadhar card number needs to be entered.
- 5. Now confirm the OTP that is sent to your number.
- 6. And click on the submit button. Your registration will be completed.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

The girls and the women for whom the scheme has been launched by the government are not aware of the scheme or are not able to register themselves for the scheme.

Hence, by coming to the doorsteps, government officials helped the girls and women by making them aware of the scheme as well as getting them registered for the scheme online.

2. Namo Shetkari Samman Yojana:

Namo Shetkari samman yojana 2023 was launched by the government of Maharashtra to provide financial help to the farmers of Maharashtra. This scheme was launched with the aim of increasing the productivity of the crops. In the scheme Rs 6000 will be given to each farmer by the state government and Rs 6000 will be given by the central government. A total amount of Rs 12000 has been given to the farmers per year.

Eligibility criteria of the farmers for this scheme:

- Applicant must be a farmer from Maharashtra.
- · Applicant must be a farmer only.
- The applying farmer must have his own land.
- The applying farmer must be registered in the agriculture department.
- The applying farmer must have a bank account in his name and his bank account must be linked to his Aadhar card.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

The farmers were not aware of the Namo Shetkari samman yojana that was introduced to help them financially. As the farmers are not educated, they faced problems in getting themselves registered online.

Hence, the government officers helped the farmers by registering them online at their doorsteps.

3. Tarbandi yojana:

The Maharashtra government has launched the Tarbandi Scheme for farmers in its budget. Farmers sometimes have to face heavy losses in crops

due to natural calamities or stray animals. To overcome these problems, the Maharashtra government has started a new initiative.

The main objective of this scheme is to protect the farmers crops from the harm caused by stray animals. Under this scheme, a subsidy will be provided to the farmers by the government of Maharashtra. Farmers of Maharashtra will be given a subsidy of up to 50% by the government of Maharashtra and will have to bear the cost of 50% on their own.

The official website created was krishi.maharashtra.gov.in

Eligibility for the scheme:

- · Applicant farmers must be permanent citizens of Maharashtra state.
- Any farmer who has 0.5 acres of land can apply for this scheme only.
- The subsidy will be provided to the farmer only after completing 400 meters of facing work in his fields.
- Small and marginal farmers of Maharashtra state can apply for this scheme only.
- The bank account of the applying farmer must be linked to his Aadhar card otherwise he cannot apply for this scheme.
- · The applying farmer must have his land papers.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

The scheme is beneficial for farmers but unfortunately farmers are unaware of this scheme.

After starting the 'Shasan Aplya dari', farmers got benefited of the Tarbandi yojana.

4. Mission Vatsalya Scheme:

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The Government of India in partnership with the state government and union territory administration release this mission Vatsalya to provide financial assistance to the children. In all states like Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, and Assam this scheme was implemented by the Chief Minister. The government provides rupees 4000 for Eligible children under the

mission Vatsalya scheme 2023. The mission also provides 24 into 7 helpline services for the children of different states and districts. The main objective behind this scheme is to provide child care and financial assistance. This is also known by the name Vatsalya Matri Amrit Kosh Yojana 2023.

The different states like Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar government appealed to the children and families who are eligible for this mission Vatsalya scheme assistants to fill out their registration forms. Centre Government introduced the scheme all over India to provide rupees 4000 for children who are under 18 years of age. The government provides this financial assistance every month to fill the economic Medical and educational development needs of poor family children.

Eligibility for this scheme:

- The child who is an orphan and living with other family members can apply for the scheme.
- · The children left by the mother.
- Children whose parents are suffering from life-threatening diseases can also apply for the scheme.
- The families who are poor and not financially and physically able to take care of their children.
- The children who are in need of protection and care and are affected by child labour and living on the street can get this assistance.
- The children who have lost their parents due to covid 19 can also register for the Mission Vatsalya scheme 2023.

Problems faced by the people and solutions provided by the government:

This scheme is for orphan children who do not have the support of their parents. The Common people are not aware of this scheme.

Thus, under 'Shasan aplya dari' yojana government officers spread the awareness among the people and solve the problems which the common people faced.

CONCLUSION:

'Shasan aplya dari' Yojana which was started by the Chief Minister of Maharashtra to aware the common people regarding the various schemes of government. There are number of issues faced by the common man to understand the various scheme of government so government has introduced 'Shasan aplya dari' Yojana to solve the problems of the common people.
