MINUTES

The 70th Annual General Meeting of the Indian Institute of Public Administration, Maharashtra Regional Branch, Mumbai was held on Friday, the 26th September, 2025 at 3.00 pm in the Parishad Sabhagruha, 6th floor, Mantralaya (Annexe), Mumbai 400 032.

Shri Swadheen S. Kshatriya, IAS (Retd.) Honorary Chairman, IIPA/MRB presided over the General Body Meeting. The list of Members who attended the meeting by physically and virtually is enclosed at Annexe-I.

At the outset, the Honorary Chairman welcomed the Hon. members and all the participants who joined the Annual General Meeting physically and virtually.

In his opening remarks Honorary Chairman, IIPA/MRB gave brief account of activities and important events organized by the Regional Branch during the year 2024-2025 till the date of the AGM including the training programmes conducted, Essay Competition held, the 30 proposals received for the "Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Memorial Award for innovation in Public Administration". IIPA, MRB has organized a lecture on the theme "Emerging Trends in Public Policy and Public Administration" Keynote address by Shri V. Srinivas, IAS, Secretary, Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, and Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances.

While mentioning about the activities of the Maharashtra Regional branch, Hon. Chairman informed that:

- I The Regional Branch has conducted one day training programme on the subject "Departmental Enquiry" jointly by G.A.D. and IIPA, Maharashtra Regional Branch on 27th June, 2025 for the Officers and staff of the administrative departments in Mantralaya (89 trainees).
- II The Govt. of Maharashtra had released ₹ 10.00 lakhs Grant-in-Aid to the Regional Branch (full grant of ₹ 10.00 lakhs) for the year 2024-2025.
During the Financial Year 2025-2026 the Government of Maharashtra has released ₹ 5.00 lakhs out of sanctioned grant of ₹ 10 lakhs vide GAD Memo dated 7th July, 2025.
- III Vide letter dated 25th June, 2025 GAD has granted approval to incorporate the following five (5) new subjects in our training programme.

1. E-governance
2. Artificial Intelligence
3. Data Analytics
4. Cyber Security and
5. Digi Locker

IV NEW PROJECT:

IIPA, New Delhi had requested for statistical information relating to implementation of Maharashtra Right to Public Services Act "Study the efficacy and effectiveness of citizen charters and service delivery Act in select central Govt. Ministries / Department of Govt and states". IIPA, Maharashtra Regional Branch agreed to collect the above statistical information and status note for submission to IIPA, New Delhi.

Accordingly, we have submitted the above statistical information and Annual Report as status note to IIPA, Delhi. For this help and cooperation, MRB is now entitled to get a sum of ₹ 15,000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand only). The sum of ₹ 15000/- has been received and deposited in bank of Baroda on 27th August, 2025.

V NEW PROJECT:

To write a book in Marathi on "Public Policy & Public Administration: In the context of Indian Literature".

IIPA has requested for the above book in Marathi language. Accordingly Late Prof. Neelima Deshmukh, Hon. Secretary of IIPA, Local Branch, Nagpur, had conveyed her acceptance to DG, IIPA, New Delhi by email dated 17/04/2025 and she had started working on this project. Unfortunately, she left for heaven suddenly. Due to her sad demise, Hon. - Chairman, IIPA of MRB proposed to entrust this above project to Shri Shekhar Gaikwad, IAS (Retd.) presently Addl. Director General & Dean Yashada, Pune and requested DG, IIPA, New Delhi to consider the name of Shri Shekhar Gaikwad, to entrust the above project to write a book on "Public Policy and Public Administration" in Marathi language. Director General of IIPA has agreed that Shri Shekhar Gaikwad may write this book.

VI NEW NANDED LOCAL BRANCH:

Election was held on 25th July, 2025 for newly established Nanded Local Branch of IIPA. Shri Rahul Kardile, IAS, Collector & District Magistrate Nanded will be the Chairman (Ex Officio); Smt. Meghna Kawli, IAS, CEO Z P Nanded will be the Vice-Chairperson, Shri Balaji Kattruwar will be the Secretary and Shri Deepak Subhash Waghmare will be the Treasurer of the Nanded Branch along with office bearers other two executive members Shri Ravi Dhondiraj Barde & Chandoba M. Kahalekar. (Enclosed a copy of elected members of Nanded Local Branch issued by Shri Yogeshkuma Bakre, Returning Officer, IIPA, and Local Branch Nanded).

We hope to have new Local Branches at Ratnagiri and Dharashiv also.

- VII Dr. Anil Pazare, Resource Knowledge Manager of Yashwant B. Chavan Pratishthan, Mumbai, offered to give some excess of books from their library to our MRB library free of cost.

We have requested to first send us the list of books which they can give us and we will select from the list in Library Committee meeting.

Prof. Ms. Kannamma Raman has brought to notice of Library Committee that every new book has a Bar Code which gives all details about the book and can easily be read by means of a scanner. This data can be easily be transferred in our system.

Mrs. Nalini Raja, Retd. Librarian, Mumbai University suggested that a hand held scanner may be purchased for the MRB library.

The Library Committee granted permission to purchase a hand held scanner for the MRB Library.

Now, data entry in excel sheet of all library books is completed and with permission of the Library Committee we have sent all this data to Soul Software Co., Gandhinagar through online, for further process.

Here, I would like to mention about the forthcoming activities of the Regional Branch.

- a) To organize Prelude Conference: "Members' Annual Conference 2025" on the theme "Emerging Trends in Public Policy and Public Administration".
- b) The Regional Branch will be issuing Press note regarding the "Late Shri B.G. Deshmukh Annual Essay Competition" for the year 2024-2025. The following topics have been selected for the Essay Competition:

- c) We will invite innovation proposals for the "Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Annual Memorial Award for Innovation in Public Administration for the year 2025-2026".
- d) Selection of winner for the "Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Memorial Award for innovation in Public Administration" for the year 2024-2025.
- e) We are planning to schedule physical training programmes during the month of October November 2025.
- f) We are also planning to organize the "Late Shri Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial lecture" and the "Late Shri B.G. Deshmukh Memorial Lecture for the year 2025-2026".

Financial Status: 2024-2025

Hony. Chairman mentioned about the financial status of the Regional Branch that during the F.Y. 2024-2025, we received ₹ 10.00 lakhs as grant from the State Government.

I would further like to mention that since the branch has been registered as Public Trust, the Income tax department has granted us exemption from paying income tax. However, to avail this exemption, we have to spend accumulated surplus income of the previous years on the objectives of the trust within next five years. Thereafter, the Hony. Chairman conducted the proceedings of the meeting as per agenda.

The Executive Committee paid homage to both departed souls by observing one-minute silence and decided to convey its heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family. One-minute silence as a mark of respect to the departed soul was observed.

It was resolved that this meeting expresses its profound sense of sorrow and grief on passing away of the above member and decided to convey its heart-felt condolence to the bereaved family.

2. Distribution of the "Late Dr. S.S. Gadkari Memorial Award for innovation in Public Administration" for the year 2024-25.

For the implementation of the Educational Innovations in Rural Areas of Nashik which are unique and praiseworthy like:

- A) JEE, NEET Coaching for students from Rural areas,
- B) Mission Atmanirbhar for Divyang students,
- C) Spelling Bee competition and
- D) Digitization of Zilla Parishad Schools

Smt. Ashima Mittal, IAS, has worked relentlessly as CEO ZP to improve the educational standards in rural areas of Nashik District.

Smt. Ashima Mittal also made a presentation online on the above innovations.

Hony. Chairman further informed that Smt. Ashima Mittal, IAS CEO ZP, Nashik due to heavy schedule she was not able to come & receive the award. The award and prize money will be sent to her by post.

3. Distribution of prizes of the "Late Shri B.G. Deshmukh Annual Essay Competition" for the year 2024-2025".

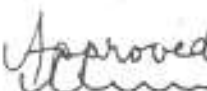
